We have an exciting fun week planned with different events every day. This week will be filled with fun and engaging activities that will help our students continue to learn and grow in a playful way before the summer vacation.

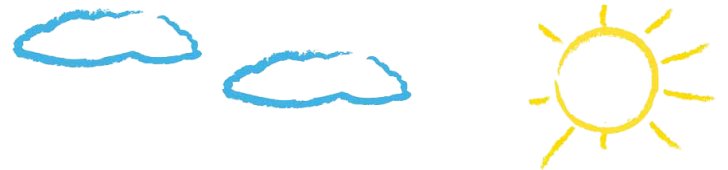
LANGUAGE ON RECORD

CIRCLE TIME

Circle time is an essential part of our daily routine. In our recent circle time with 3 to 4-year-old students, we have been focusing on developing language and communication skills, practicing expressing emotions, and exploring nature and science.



STORY TIME

During story time, children gather and listen to their teacher reading stories. This is a special time where children can use their imaginations, explore new vocabulary, and develop their listening skills, Good Habits was the topic of our story time.

QURANIC RECITATION

Quranic Recitation class takes place every Friday for 20 minutes. During this time, with Qari Sahab, children recite short Surahs like Surah Al-Ikhlâs, Surah Al-Kausar, and Surah Al-Asr and Masnoon Duas including dua before and after eating and sleep, to enhance their recitation skills and deepen their understanding of the Quran.



MUSIC CLASS

Music class takes place every Monday for 20 minutes.

Children learnt about good habits, shapes, colors, and fruits through singing poems and songs. Our experienced music teacher also plays the Piano to provide musical accompaniment and enhance the learning experience. It's a fun and interactive way for children to develop their cognitive and language skills while enjoying the benefits of music education.

Reading is a great way to promote language development and cognitive skills. Take some time each day to read with your child and encourage them to explore different types of books.



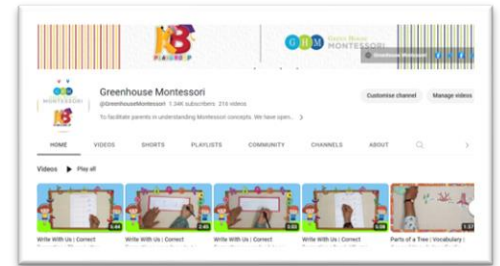
ASSEMBLY PRESENTATION
